Children's Hospital Pyjamas Charity

Our pupil leadership team have decided to support a local charity that provides pyjamas for children in hospitals or hospices in the run up to Christmas.

We are encouraging children to bring a pair of new pyjamas or we are taking cash donations which we will then purchase pyjamas on your behalf which will then be donated to the charity. Please send the cash into school in a sealed envelope.



The pyjamas are used in emergency situations where children may have had their clothes cut or families haven't had time to pack essentials, some are also given to children in hospital on Christmas morning.

Please donate a pair of non-fleecy pyjamas from aged new born to 18 years to school this week, the pupil leadership team will organise them and the charity will come to school to collect donations the week after.

All of the pyjamas donated have a pair of hand stitched hearts added to them, this allows one heart to stay with the child in hospital and the other to go home with their family who cannot be with them. These lovely hearts are hand sewn by a team of over 1000 volunteers from all over the country.

Flu Immunisation - online consent



Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Children can catch and spread flu easily. Vaccinating your child also protects vulnerable family members and friends.

The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, types of flu can vary, so it is recommended to have it annually to maximise protection. Since the vaccine programme was introduced, most children offered the vaccine in schools have been immunised annually.


Year 4 Roman Britain


