#### Flu Immunisation - online consent

The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, types of flu can vary, so it is recommended to have it annually to maximise protection. Since the vaccine programme was introduced, most children offered the vaccine in schools have been immunised annually.

To consent to your child having the nasal spray flu vaccine please complete the easy-to-use e-consent form via the link below, using the code for Townfield.






Your child will this week have brought home details of the Xmas 4 schools for your personalised Christmas cards and gifts.
