

Year 3 World Museum Liverpool

In the Spring term, the children in Year 3 will be learning all about Ancient Greece.

We are therefore really excited to be able to take all of the Year 3 children on a day trip to World Museum Liverpool on Thursday 25th January 2024 to look around their 'Return

of the Gods' exhibition. This will be a memorable day and a wonderful opportunity for the children to further enhance their learning about Ancient Greece.

During the trip, the children will also take part in a 'Discover Ancient Greeks and Romans' workshop which will be led by staff at the museum and are designed to stimulate and inspire the children with their learning.

The price of the trip will be approximately £12.20 per child and includes return coach journey to World Museum Liverpool and entrance to the workshops.

Year 5 World Museum Liverpool

As part of our science topic on Earth and Space, Year 5 will be going on an exciting trip to the World Museum in Liverpool on Thursday 7th December. The trip will include a visit to the planetarium where they will take part in the Go CAPCOM-Go workshop. In this museum-led workshop pupils will watch Capcom Go, a visually captivating show in our full domed planetarium, which explores the question: How did humans walk on the moon?



Children will also be given the chance to explore the rest of the museum including the space exhibition. In the afternoon, the children will visit the Walker Art Gallery where they will have the chance to practice their art skills by drawing some of the fantastic artwork that is displayed.

Flu Immunisation - online consent

Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Children can catch and spread flu easily. Vaccinating your child also protects vulnerable family members and friends.



The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, types of flu can vary, so it is recommended to have it annually to maximise protection. Since the vaccine programme was introduced, most children offered the vaccine in schools have been immunised annually.
