Flu Immunisation - online consent

Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Children can catch and spread flu easily. Vaccinating your child also protects vulnerable family members and friends.

The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, types of flu can vary, so it is recommended to have it annually to maximise protection. Since the vaccine programme was introduced, most children offered the vaccine in schools have been immunised annually.

flu: 5 reasons to vaccinate your child

- ✓ **1. Protect your child.** The vaccine will help protect your child against flu and serious complications such as bronchitis and pneumonia
- ✓ **2. Protect you, your family and friends.** Vaccinating your child will help protect more vulnerable family and friends
- ✓ **3. No injection needed.** The nasal spray is painless and easy to have
- ✓ **4. It's better than having flu.** The nasal spray helps protect against flu, has been given to millions of children worldwide and has an excellent safety record
- ✓ **5. Avoid costs.** If your child gets flu, you may have to take time off work or arrange alternative childcare

We had a fantastic time in Y2 completing a 'Lego Fairground Workshop' with Junior Stem.

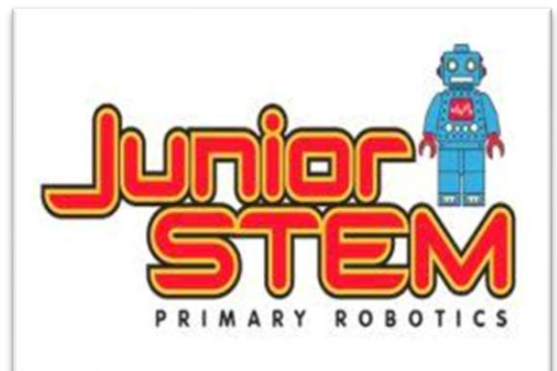
First, we studied the basic commands needed to program the Lego Wedo 2.0 software, while making a simple model of our own design.

Please have a go at this - It would be great if we won!

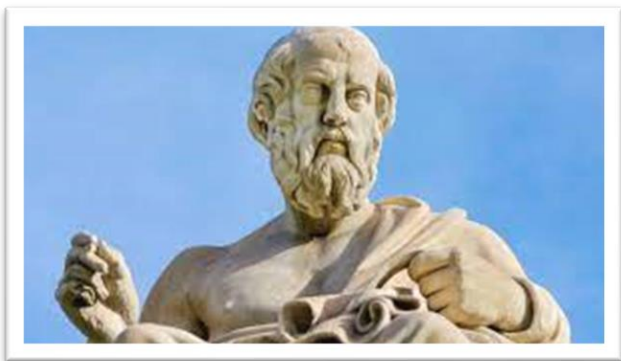
School Photographs

In this museum-led workshop pupils will watch Capcom Go, a visually captivating show in our full domed planetarium, which explores the question: How did humans walk on the moon?



Children will also be given the chance to explore the rest of the museum including the space exhibition. In the afternoon, the children will visit the Walker Art Gallery where they will have the chance to practice their art skills by drawing some of the fantastic artwork that is displayed.

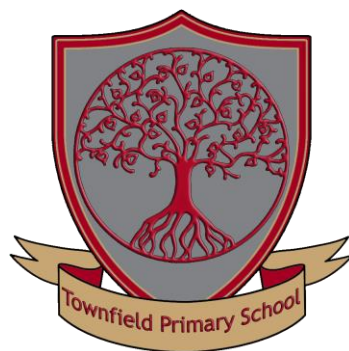

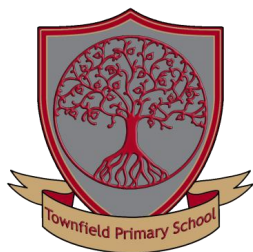
