

If you are able to volunteer to accompany us on the trip then please inform Miss McLoughlin or Miss Johnson.


Geography Field Trip

You will be guided into a classroom where you can look at your child(ren)'s books then you will have your allocated time with your class teacher.




Parents' Evenings Drop-Ins

Attendance- colds


