Year 2 Healthy Kebabs

In Year 2, their DT topic is 'Healthy Kebabs'. For their first lesson, they got to evaluate a range of vegetables such as, peppers, olives, carrots, cucumber, tomatoes and mushrooms. They had to think about the name of the vegetables, where it is grown and use adjectives to describe what it looked and felt like. The children then got to smell and

taste the vegetables! They then had to think about which vegetable they preferred and which one they would include in their final

product, which is a healthy kebab. Year 2 really enjoyed this lesson and tasting vegetables they have never tried before!


