Townfield Assembly

On Tuesday 23rd April, Sean and Andy from the RNLI came to school to talk to Key Stage 2 about water safety.

The children (and adults) learnt all about the meaning of each colour flag when at the beach and the key safety messages promoted by the RNLI to keep ourselves safe around water including:

- 'Slip (on sunglasses), Slap (on a sun hat), Slop (on some sunscreen) and Slurp (some water),
- Stay Together
- Float on your back if you get in to trouble (caught in a rip current), waving your arms and shouting for help - try not to panic
- Call 999 or 112 and ask for the Coastguard if you see someone in trouble in the water.

It was a very interactive and informative assembly with children volunteering to hold the flags, dress up as lifeguards and even rescue Miss James when she drifted away in a rip current through the hall! Most of all though, it was incredibly important for the children to learn such valuable information especially as we are now approaching summer and (hopefully) warmer temperatures where we may find ourselves at the beach.

Knife Crime Talk



On Wednesday, Year 5 were visited by our local Police Community Support Officer Peter Shone who came to talk about knife crime. He also played out some scenarios of what might happen in a situation if someone was carrying a knife. All of the scenarios were bad and we learnt that no good comes from knives.




